Dip the green vegetable into salt water.

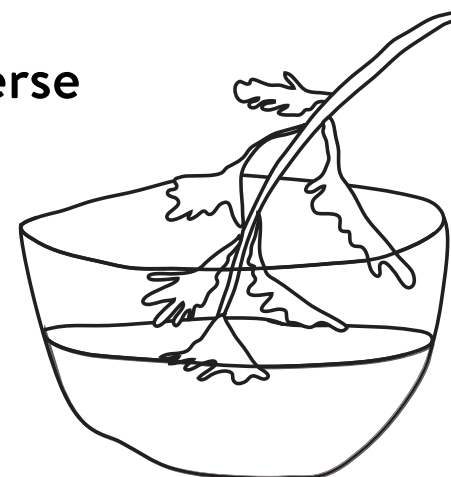

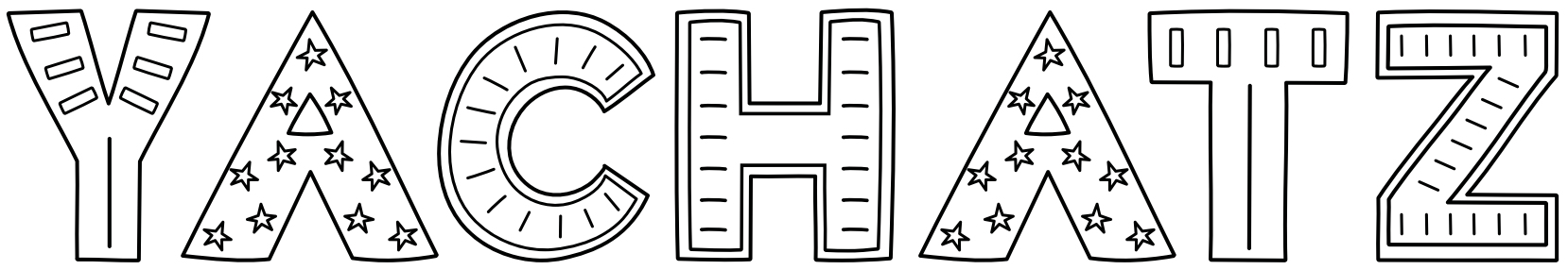

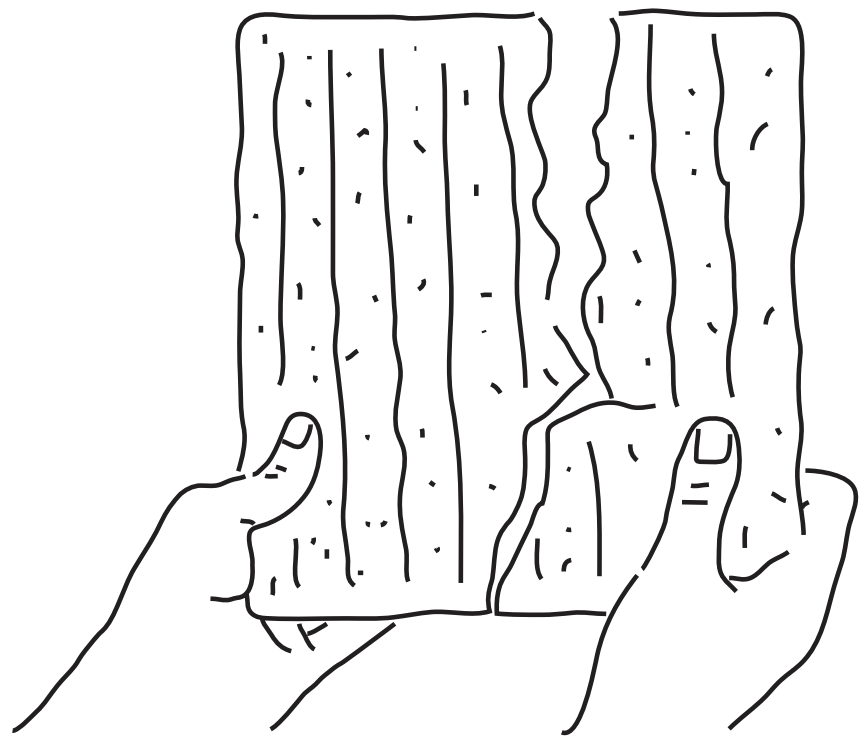

Break the middle matzah.



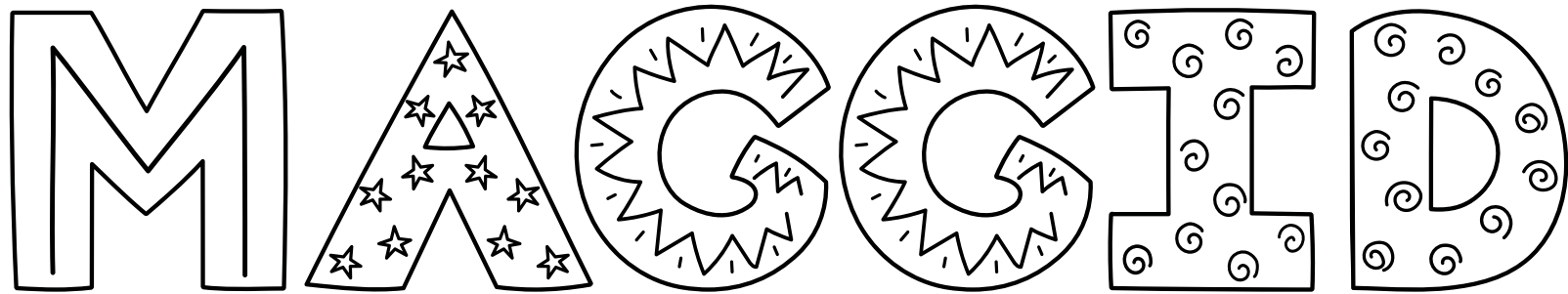

Wrap up the larger half & hide it as the afikoman.

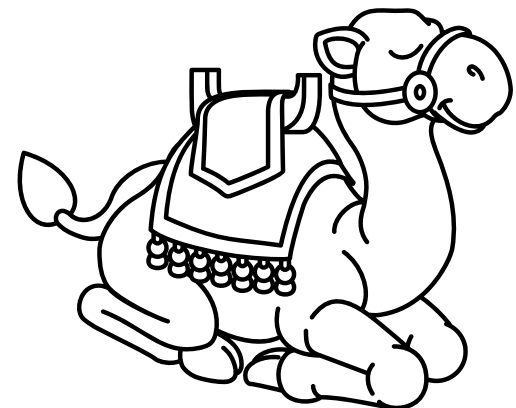
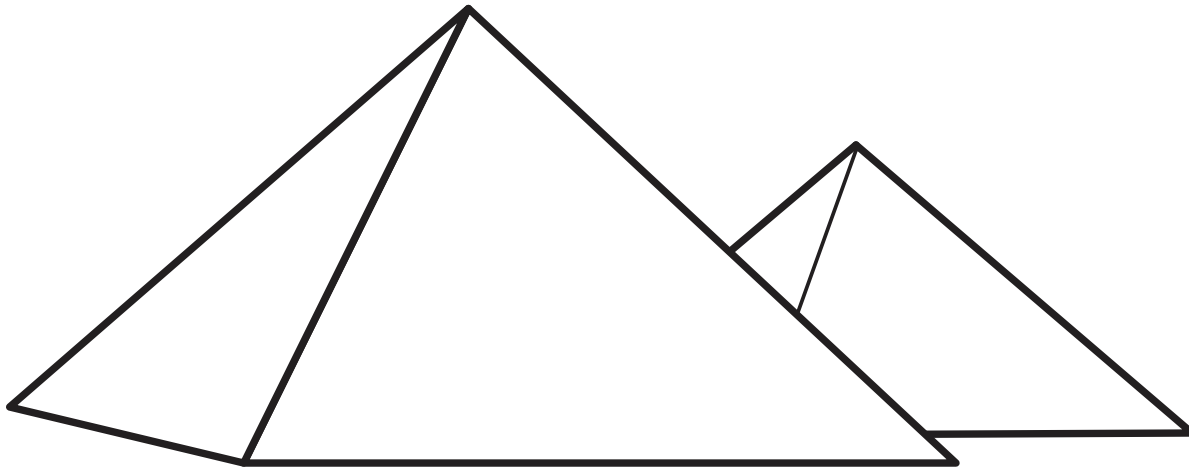

How do the Passover rituals make you feel?



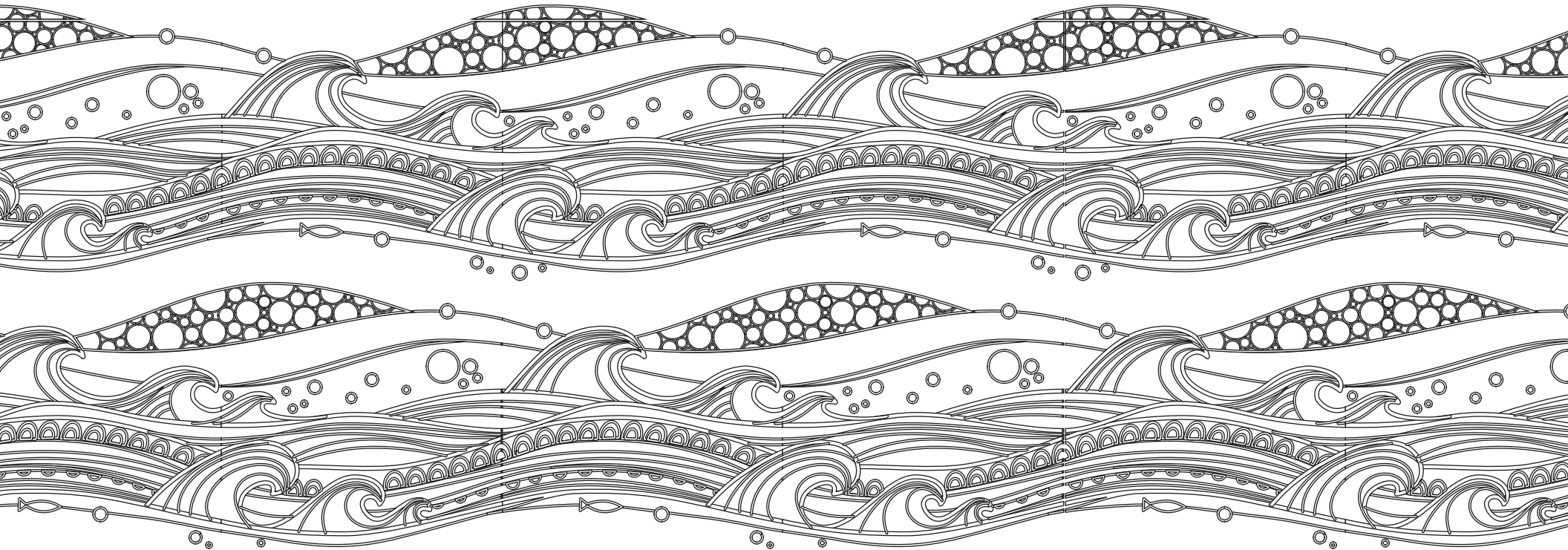

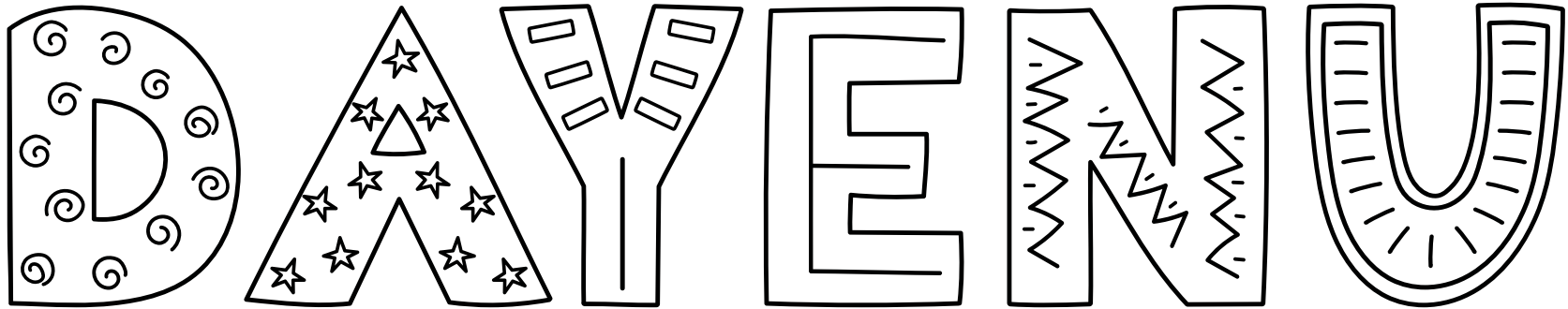


Blood - Frogs - Vermin - Flies - Cattle disease
Boils - Hail - Locusts - Darkness - Death of the first born

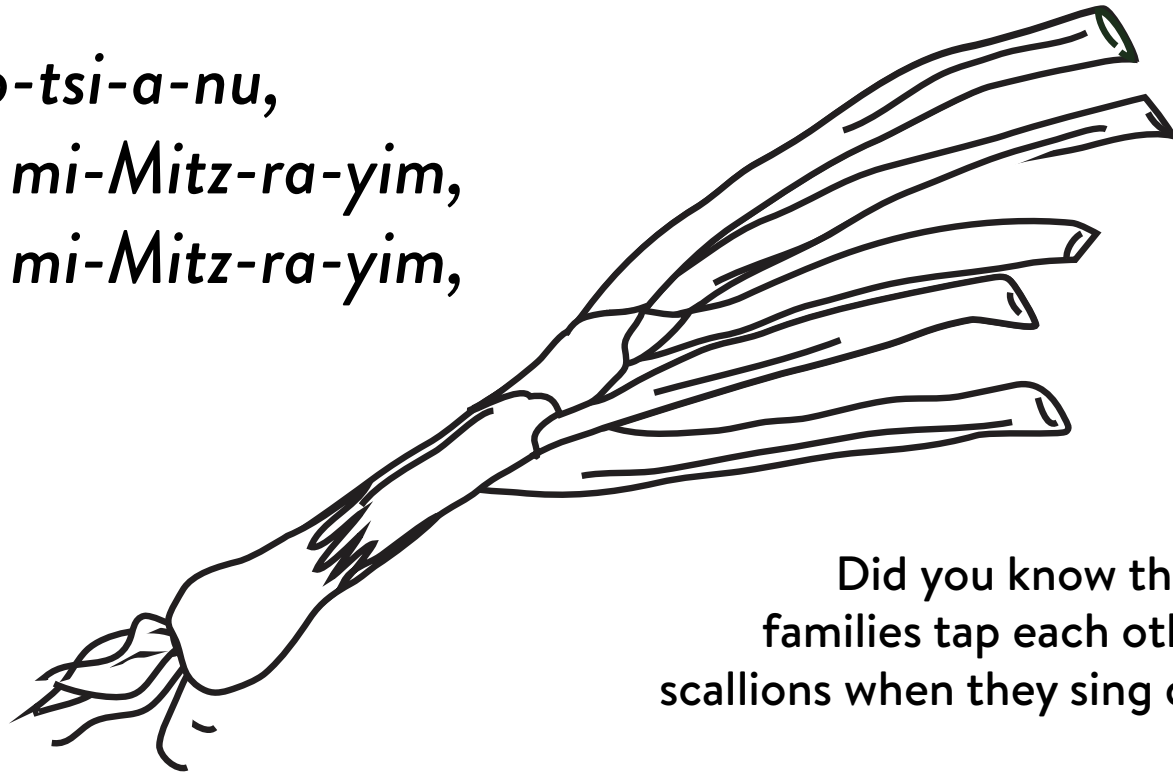
Imagine you're a slave in Egypt. You and your family have to leave in a hurry and cross the Red Sea.

Sing a song about gratitude.

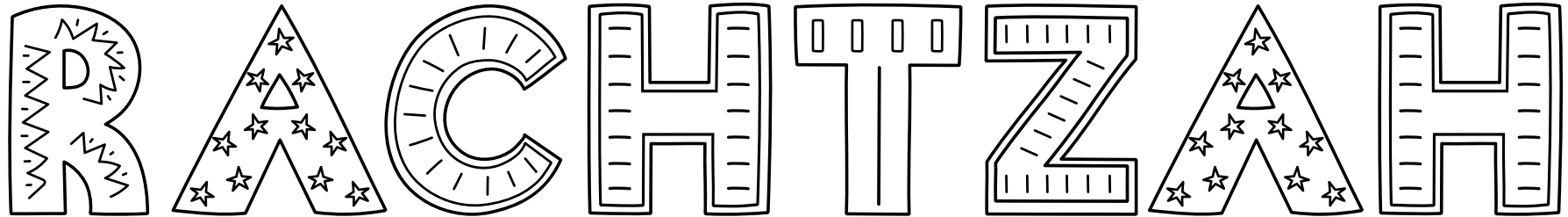
